## Workshop Programme 2012

HSP runs a comprehensive workshop programme for local coaches and club volunteers.

Safeguarding & Protecting Children, Equity in Your Coaching and First Aid workshops are held every 4 to 6 weeks as they are required for Clubmark accreditation and some coaching awards. Other more developmental workshops such as long-term athlete development, how to coach disabled people in sport, role of the volunteer coordinator and Sport England Small Grants are run less frequently

HSP remains the largest provider of workshops in the region and this year many of the workshops will take place at convenient locations around the county rather than just being held at Hatfield.
